ORDER OF REVOCATION

THIS PROCEEDING CAME on for final agency action and the Chief Financial Officer, having considered the record, including the Administrative Complaint filed on March 10, 2015, and being fully advised in the premises, finds that:

1. Kendra Leanna Johnson is currently licensed by the Department of Financial Services (the "Department"), pursuant to the Florida Insurance Code, as a customer representative.
2. On March 10, 2015, the Department issued an Administrative Complaint, attached hereto as "Exhibit A," against Kendra Leanna Johnson, alleging that on December 16, 2014, in the Circuit Court for the Tenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Polk County, Florida, Case No. 2014CF-005998-A000, she pled guilty to one count of Grand Theft and one count of Scheme to Defraud, both felonies. Adjudication of guilt was withheld.
3. The Department notified Kendra Leanna Johnson in the Administrative Complaint of the right to request a proceeding in accordance with sections 120.569 and 120.57,

Florida Statutes, and that failure to answer the Administrative Complaint or request a proceeding within twenty-one (21) days would result in the imposition of a penalty.

4. In accordance with section 624.310(6), Florida Statutes, the Department served the Administrative Complaint upon Kendra Leanna Johnson by certified mail on March 20, 2015.

5. Kendra Leanna Johnson failed to answer the Administrative Complaint or request a proceeding in accordance with sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes.

FINDINGS OF FACT

6. The factual allegations contained in the Administrative Complaint dated March 10, 2015, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and fully incorporated herein by reference, are hereby adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact in this case.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7. Based upon the Findings of Fact adopted herein, the Department concludes that Kendra Leanna Johnson violated the specific statutes and rules charged in each count of the Administrative Complaint, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and hereby adopts the violations charged in each count of the Administrative Complaint as the Conclusions of Law in this case.

PENALTY IMPOSED

8. The failure of Kendra Leanna Johnson to answer the Administrative Complaint or request a proceeding, taken together with the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law adopted herein, constitutes grounds for the Chief Financial Officer to revoke the licenses of Kendra Leanna Johnson.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(a) All licenses, appointments and eligibility for licensure heretofore issued to Kendra Leanna Johnson, within the purview of the Department, are hereby revoked.

(b) Kendra Leanna Johnson does not have the right to apply for another license or appointment under the Florida Insurance Code for a period of two (2) years from the effective date of revocation. The Department shall not thereafter grant Kendra Leanna Johnson a new license or appointment or reinstate eligibility to hold such license or appointment if it finds that the circumstance or circumstances for which the license was revoked still exist or are likely to recur, or if Kendra Leanna Johnson is not otherwise eligible for licensure.

(c) During the period of revocation, and until a new license is issued, Kendra Leanna Johnson shall not engage in or attempt or profess to engage in any transaction or business for which a license or appointment is required under the Florida Insurance Code or directly or indirectly own, control, or be employed in any manner by any insurance agent or agency or adjuster or adjusting firm.

(d) Within ten (10) calendar days of the issuance of this Order of Revocation, Kendra Leanna Johnson shall return all licenses issued to her pursuant to the Florida Insurance Code to the Department of Financial Services, Bureau of Licensing, 200 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0319.

(e) Any person who knowingly transacts insurance or otherwise engages in insurance activities in this state without a license, or while the license is suspended or revoked, commits a felony of the third degree.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

Any party to these proceedings adversely affected by this Order is entitled to seek review within thirty (30) days of the rendition of this Order, pursuant to section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and Rule 9.190, *Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure*. Review proceedings must be instituted by filing a petition or notice of appeal with Julie Jones, the DFS Agency Clerk. Filing with the Agency Clerk may be accomplished via U.S. Mail, express overnight delivery, hand delivery, facsimile transmission, or electronic mail. 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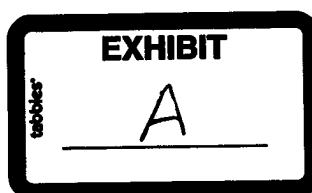
ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Kendra Leanna Johnson, license #E068536, is hereby notified that the Chief Financial Officer of the State of Florida has caused to be made an investigation of her activities while licensed as a customer representative in this state, as a result of which it is alleged:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

1. Pursuant to chapter 626, Florida Statutes, Kendra Leanna Johnson is currently licensed in this state as a customer representative.
2. At all times pertinent to the dates and occurrences referred to herein, Kendra Leanna Johnson was licensed in this state as a customer representative.
3. Pursuant to chapter 626, Florida Statutes, the Florida Department of Financial Services (the "Department") has jurisdiction over her insurance license and appointments.



COUNT I

4. The above general allegations are hereby realleged and fully incorporated herein by reference.

5. On December 16, 2014, in the Circuit Court for the Tenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Polk County, Florida, Case No. 2014CF-005998-A000, Kendra Leanna Johnson pled guilty to one count of Grand Theft and one count of Scheme to Defraud, both felonies. Adjudication of guilt was withheld.

IT IS THEREFORE CHARGED that Kendra Leanna Johnson has violated one or more of the following provisions of the Florida Statutes or Florida Administrative Code, which constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation of her license as a customer representative in this state:


(a) Section 626.611(1)(n), Florida Statutes, which provides that it is a violation for any applicant, agent, title agency, adjuster, customer representative, service representative, or managing general agent to be found guilty of or to enter a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a felony or a crime punishable by imprisonment of 1 year or more under the law of the United States of America or of any state thereof or under the law of any other country which involves moral turpitude, without regard to whether a judgment of conviction has been entered by the court having jurisdiction of such cases.

(b) Section 626.621(8), Florida Statutes, which provides that it is a violation to be found guilty of or to plead guilty or nolo contendere to a felony or a crime punishable by imprisonment of 1 year or more under the law of the United States of America or of any state thereof or under the law of any other country, without regard to whether a judgment of conviction has been entered by the court having jurisdiction of such cases.

WHEREFORE, Kendra Leanna Johnson is hereby notified that the Chief Financial Officer intends to enter an Order revoking her license and appointments as a customer representative or to impose such penalties as may be provided under the provisions of sections 626.611, 626.621, 626.641, 626.681, 626.691, and 626.9521, Florida Statutes, and chapter 69B-231, *Florida Administrative Code*, including, but not limited to, Rule 69B-231.150, *Florida Administrative Code*, and under the other referenced sections of the Florida Statutes as set out in this Administrative Complaint.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

You have the right to request a proceeding to contest this action by the Department pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, and chapter 28-106, *Florida Administrative Code*. The proceeding request must be in writing, signed by you, and must be filed with the Department within twenty-one (21) days of your receipt of this notice. Completion of the attached Election of Proceeding form and a petition for administrative hearing are required. The request must be filed with Julie Jones, DFS Agency Clerk, at the Florida Department of Financial Services, 612 Larson Building, 200 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0390. Your written response must be received by the Department no later than 5:00 p.m. on the twenty-first day after your receipt of this notice. Mailing the response on the twenty-first day will not preserve your right to a hearing.

FAILURE TO ENSURE THAT YOUR WRITTEN RESPONSE IS RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN TWENTY-ONE (21) DAYS OF YOUR RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE WILL CONSTITUTE A WAIVER OF YOUR RIGHT TO REQUEST A PROCEEDING ON THE MATTERS ALLEGED HEREIN AND A FINAL ORDER OF SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION WILL BE ENTERED AGAINST YOU.

If you request a proceeding, you must provide information that complies with the requirements of Rule 28-106.2015, *Florida Administrative Code*. Specifically, your response must contain:

(a) The name, address, telephone number, and facsimile number (if any) of the respondent (for the purpose of requesting a hearing in this matter, you are the "respondent").

(b) The name, address, telephone number, and facsimile number of the attorney or qualified representative of the respondent (if any) upon whom service of pleadings and other papers shall be made.

(c) A statement requesting an administrative hearing identifying those material facts that are in dispute. If there are none, the petition must so indicate.

(d) A statement of when the respondent received notice of the administrative complaint.

(e) A statement including the file number of the administrative complaint.

If a hearing of any type is requested, you have the right to be represented by counsel or other qualified representative at your expense, to present evidence and argument, to call and cross-examine witnesses, and to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents by subpoena.

If a proceeding is requested and there is no dispute of material fact, the provisions of section 120.57(2), Florida Statutes, apply. In this regard, you may submit oral or written evidence in opposition to the action taken by the Department or a written statement challenging the grounds upon which the Department has relied. While a hearing is normally not required in the absence of a dispute of fact, if you feel that a hearing is necessary, one will be conducted in Tallahassee, Florida, or by telephonic conference call upon your request.

However, if you dispute material facts which are the basis for the Department's action, you must request an adversarial proceeding pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes. These proceedings are held before an administrative law judge of the State of Florida Division of Administrative Hearings. Unless the majority of witnesses are located elsewhere, the Department will request that the hearing be conducted in Tallahassee, Florida.

Failure to follow the procedure outlined with regard to your response to this notice may result in the request being denied. All prior oral communication or correspondence in this matter shall be considered free form agency action, and no such oral communication or correspondence

shall operate as a valid request for an administrative proceeding. Any request for an administrative proceeding received before the date of this notice shall be deemed abandoned unless timely renewed in compliance with the guidelines as set out above.

Mediation of this matter pursuant to section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available. No Department attorney will discuss this matter with you during the time frame in which you have to request a hearing.
